

CURRENT BENEFICE SERVICES

Following the Government's lifting in July of restrictions which had closed places of Worship in March, we have been holding 10am short said services in each of our 5 Parishes churches during August

During September our 10am SAID Services will continue as follows with a few variations:

11am Harvest Festival at Colmworth Farm outside
(not at the Parish Church)

You are welcome to bring a picnic to eat afterwards sitting socially distanced)

5pm Harvest Festival at Wilden Parish Church

If the weather is fine we may hold these popular services outside in the churchyard to accommodate more people than we can fit socially distanced inside our churches
Please wrap up warmly & bring a chair/rug and perhaps a hot drink in a flask with your picnic.

As we expect larger numbers at our Harvest Festivals

We want to give priority to each Parish's local community and their own parishioners
(Harvest Festivals at Ravenden and Keysoe will be on Sunday 4th October)
